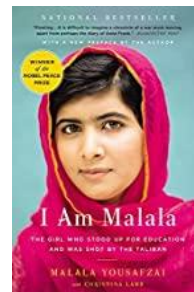
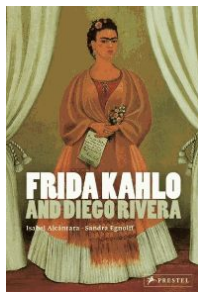
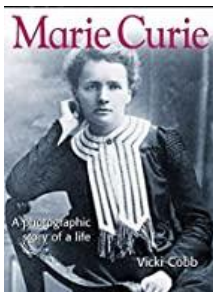
## 2. Recommended books

## 3. New books and big readers

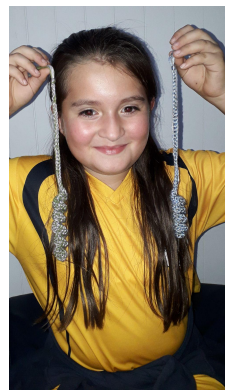
### New Spanish Books
