
### **Library at Lunch**


Every day at lunch for Book Week, there was an optional creative activity.

### 6. Book Week - Secondary School

#### Drop everything and read

Students in Secondary continued the tradition of "drop everything and read" during book week this year. For 15 minutes at the top of every first block, they stopped what they were doing and read quietly. We were pleasantly surprised to see participation from students, teacher and other staff in the activity!

#### Workshops

In the third block of each day, students from 6th-9th grade participated in workshops relating to our theme of "paper". Some put together sculptures from paper craft, while others made origami. Some students also produced miniature books and tried their hand at printing newspaper articles.

#### **Trip to La Nacion**

The 11th grade students were taken on a trip to Costa Rica's national newspaper "La Nacion", where they heard talks on the history of the paper, its mission to inform the nation's people and its role as a mouthpiece for free and open discourse in Latin America's longest running and most stable democracy.





### 7. Exploring Destiny Discover

- 1. Follow this link to get to <u>Destiny Discover</u>.
- 2. Click on Login in the top right corner. Every student at PAS has a username and password. The username is the start of your email address and your password is the number on your ID.
- 3. You can now use Destiny Discover!
